None of our surfaces is a "normal" one like it finds use on daily life objects. We formally want to express, that it is your duty to take care of your personal WEDENSTEIN product in a proper way in order to ensure a long and satisfying life cycle.

High-gloss surfaces require a lot of expertise in manufacturing **and** maintaining.

Please avoid direct contact with hard materials, rubbing or shocking the surface. Scratches and marks will appear. A powerful rule: The more gloss, the more vulnerability.

Please avoid contact with aggressive or abrasive chemicals. A glossy surface is best protected as long as it is closed-pored. By using chemicals or abrasives, you will open the pores and increase the chance of mattening and hurting the surface irreversibly.

Please remove rests of sweat, food and beverages immediately. They often contain organic or anorganic acidities, which can affect the surface, leave marks or stains.

Please do not add masking tape or any other sticky product to the surface. Tapes and foils mostly bring in tension in the surface, which will be followed by visible irregularities or damages in the top-layers.

For cleaning, please use only clean wet micro-fibre rags and – when necessary – mild soap or mild stretched glass cleaner. Rubbing too heavy or scraping with finger nails will cause scratches and marks. Inappropriate polishing can bring in too much heat and damage the surface.

Do always handle parts with a high-gloss finish at tight room temperature range. Heat will make the surface soft and vulnerable and additionally cause shrinking, of the commodity, which can lead to orange peeling and irregularities.

Please avoid direct sunlight or other UV radiation.

When covering / protecting the surface, make sure you use a proper type of textile and avoid too much weight or pressure. This can cause scratches, marks and irregularities.

We recommend a wax polish / sealer and a soft micro-fibre rag to maintain the gloss. If you are not sure, feel free to ask a WEDENSTEIN professional. We'll be there for you.
